Geeta wants something sweet to eat.



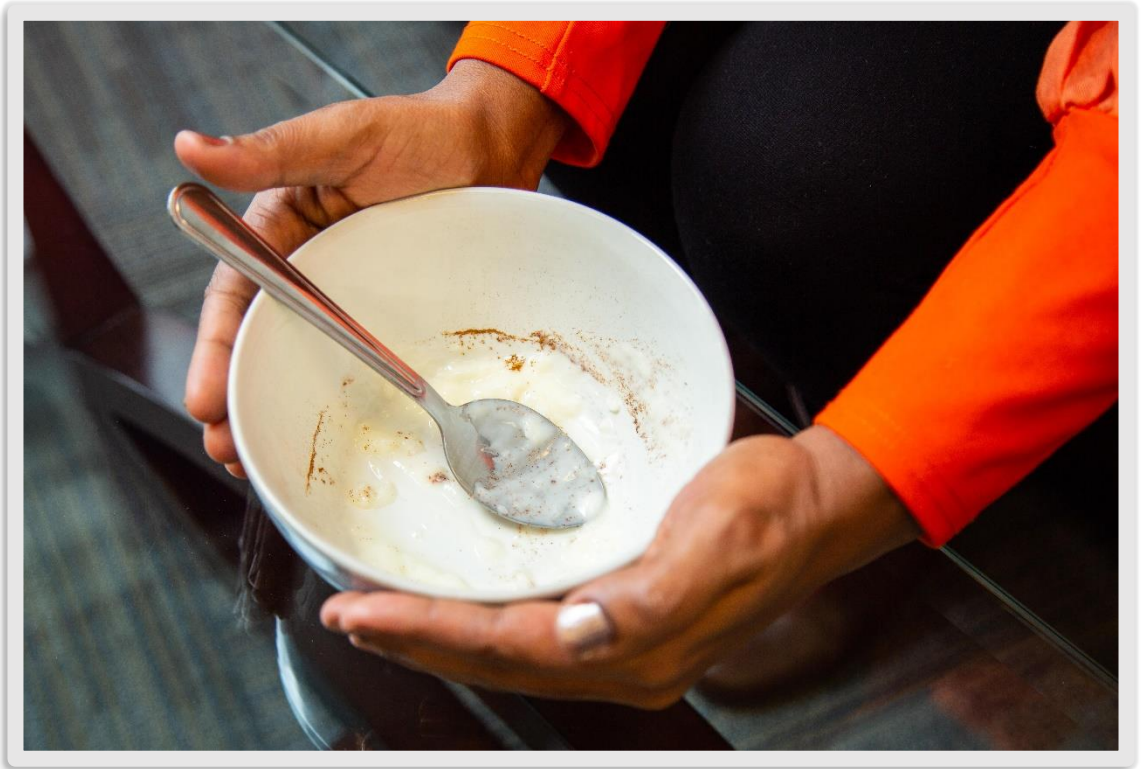

She heats up the kheer.



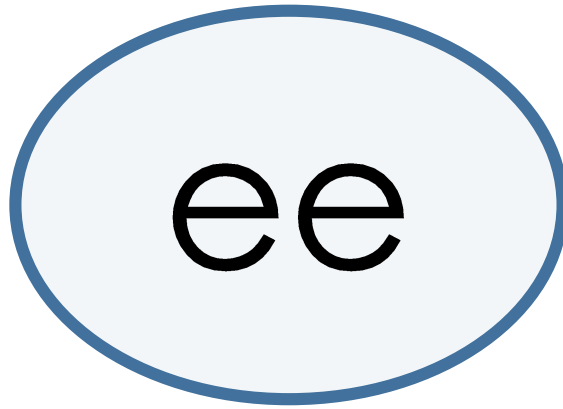
Geeta eats the sweet treat.
