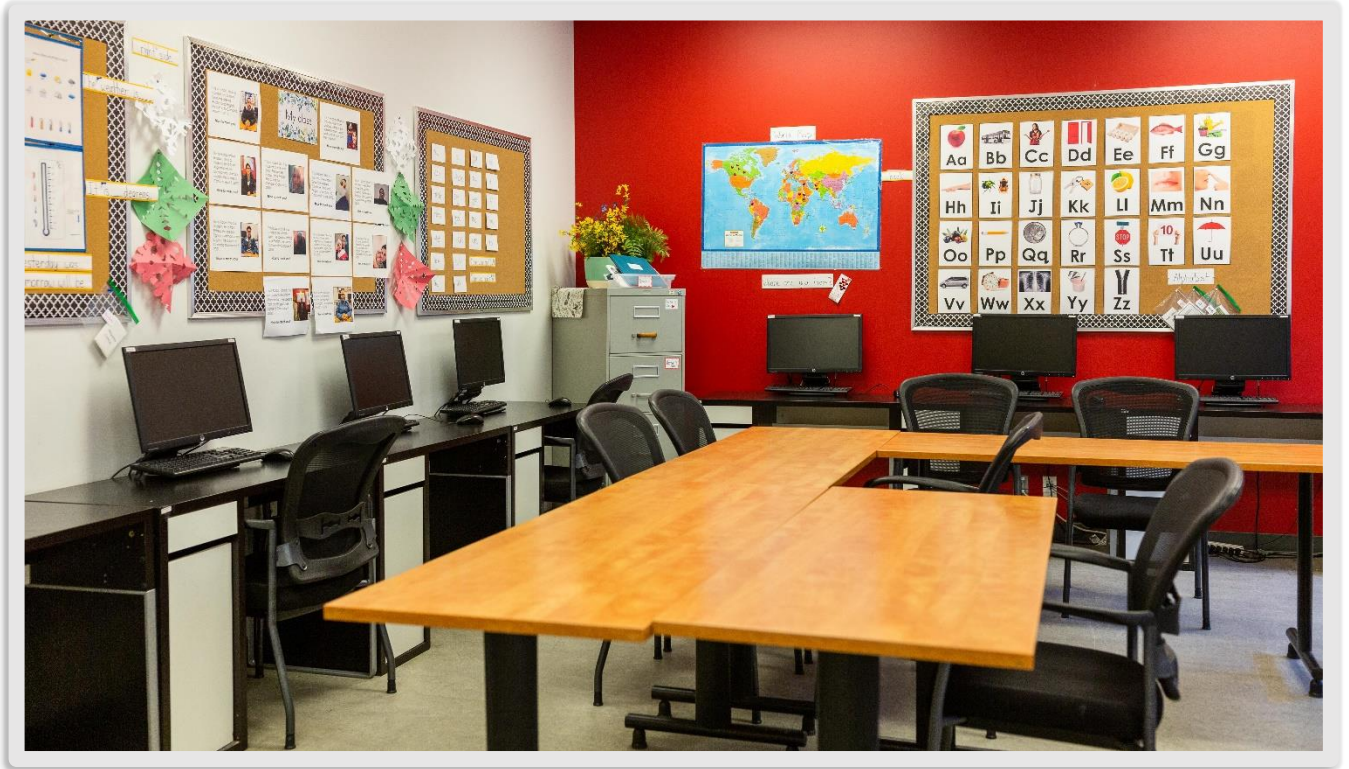

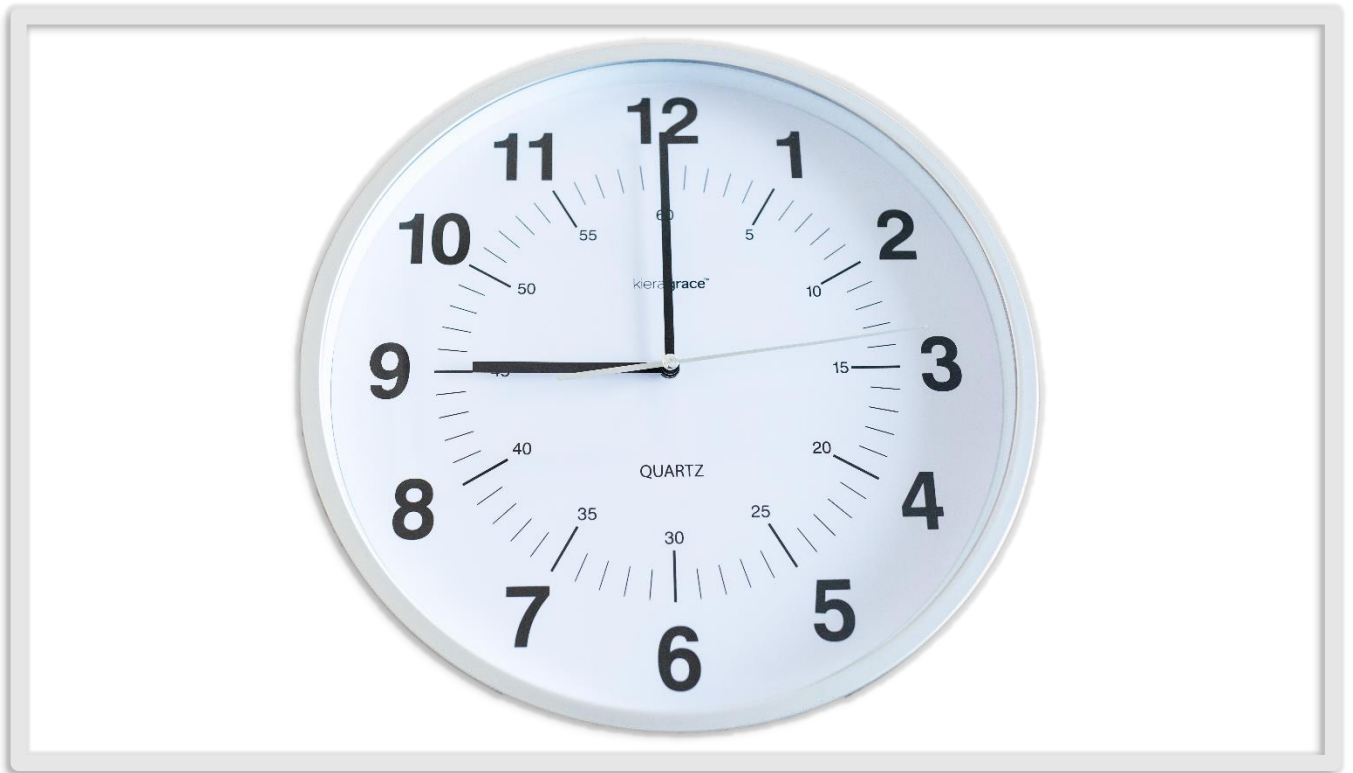

Jacob has English school today.



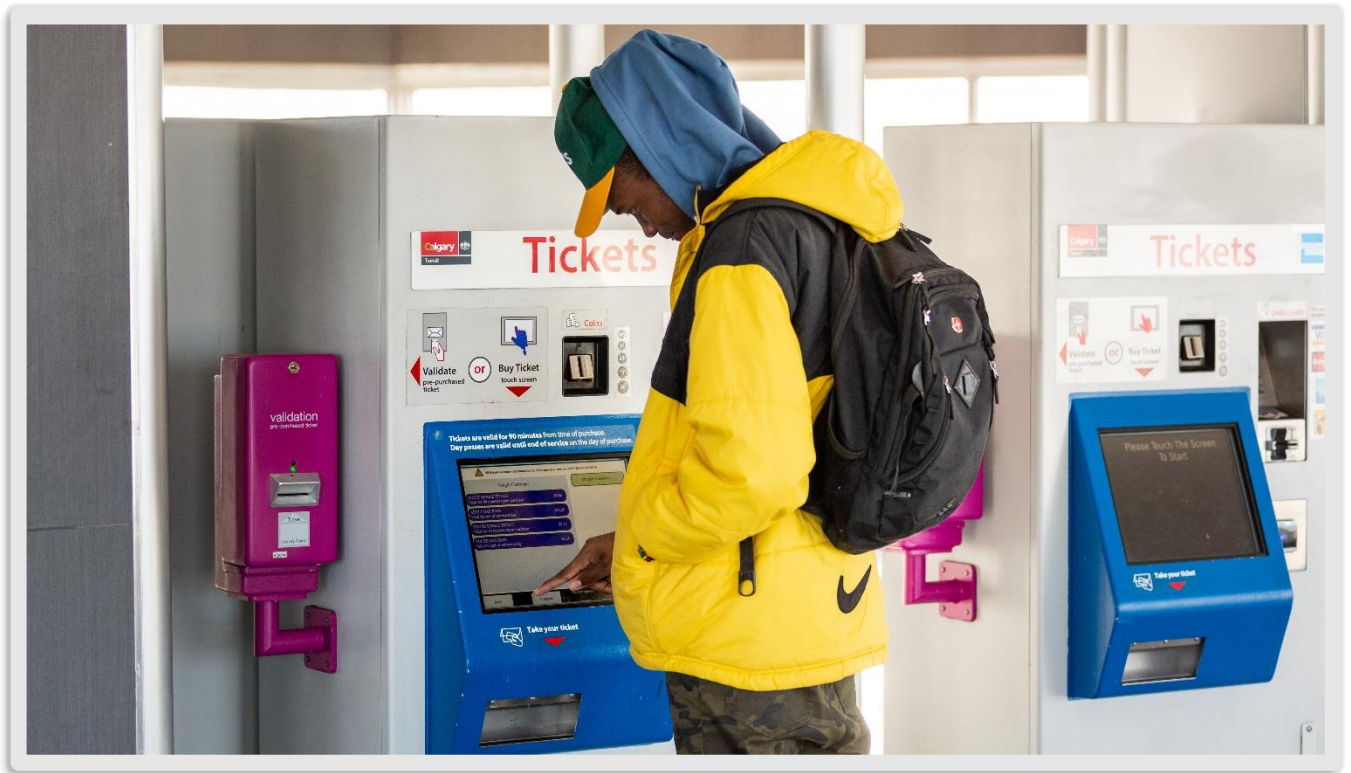
His class starts at 9:00 a.m.

He has to pay for a single ticket.



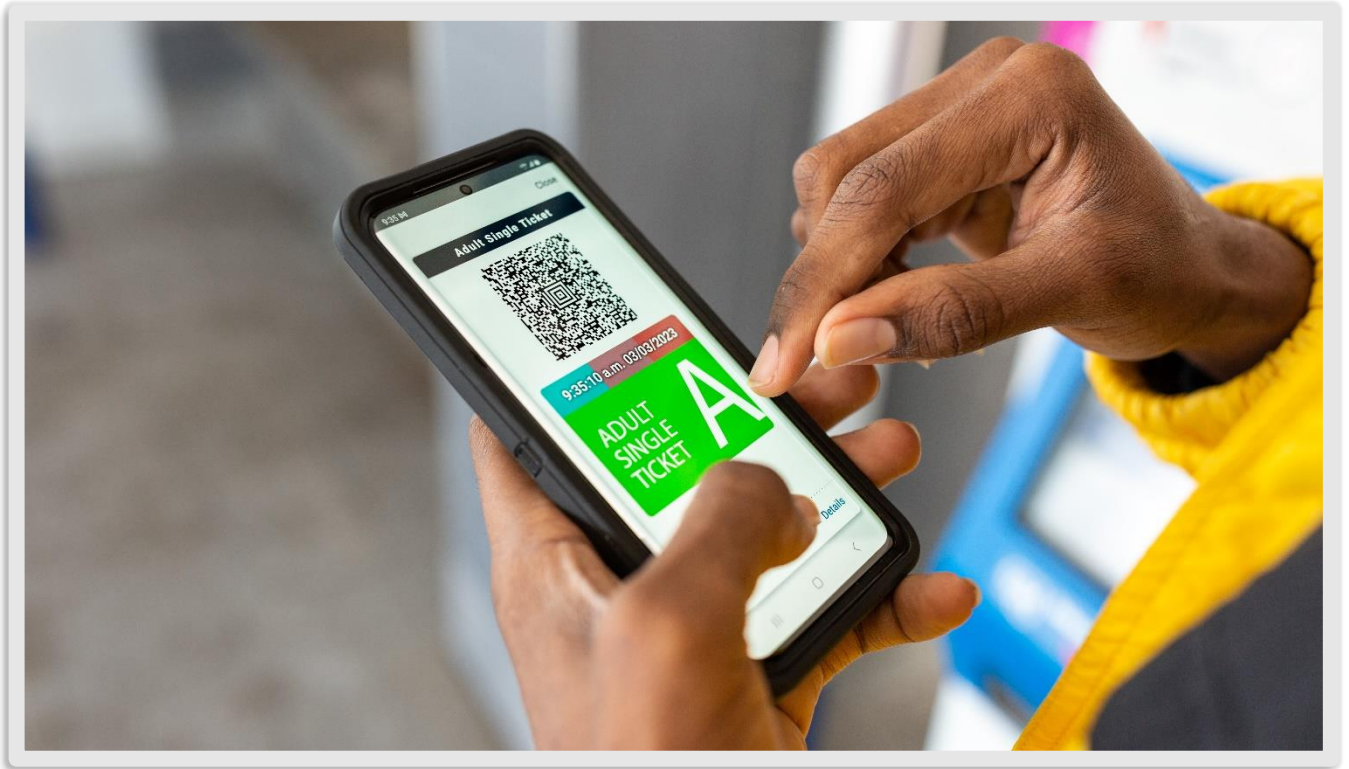
Jacob looks in his backpack for cash.



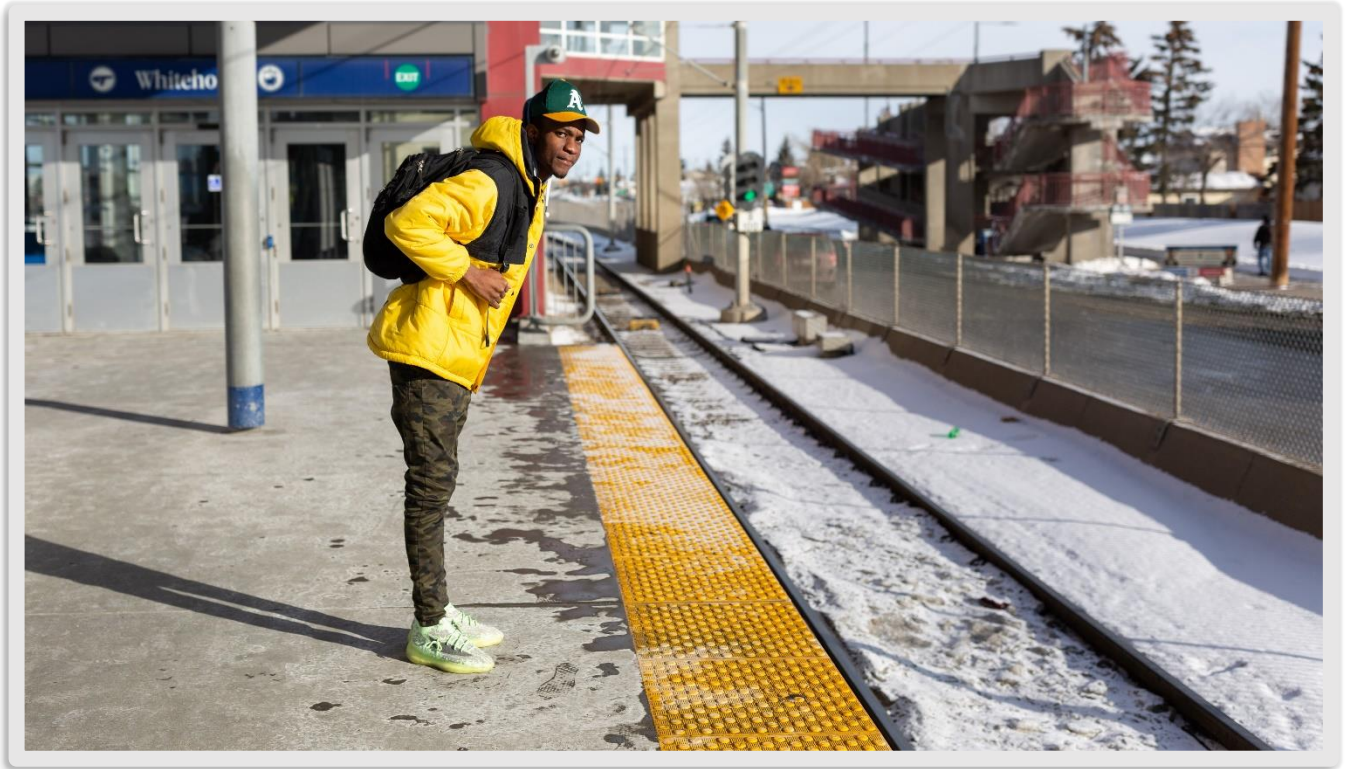
Oh no! He forgot his cash at home.



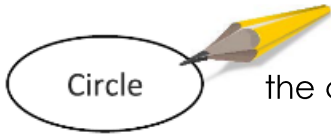
That's okay, he can use the transit app.
