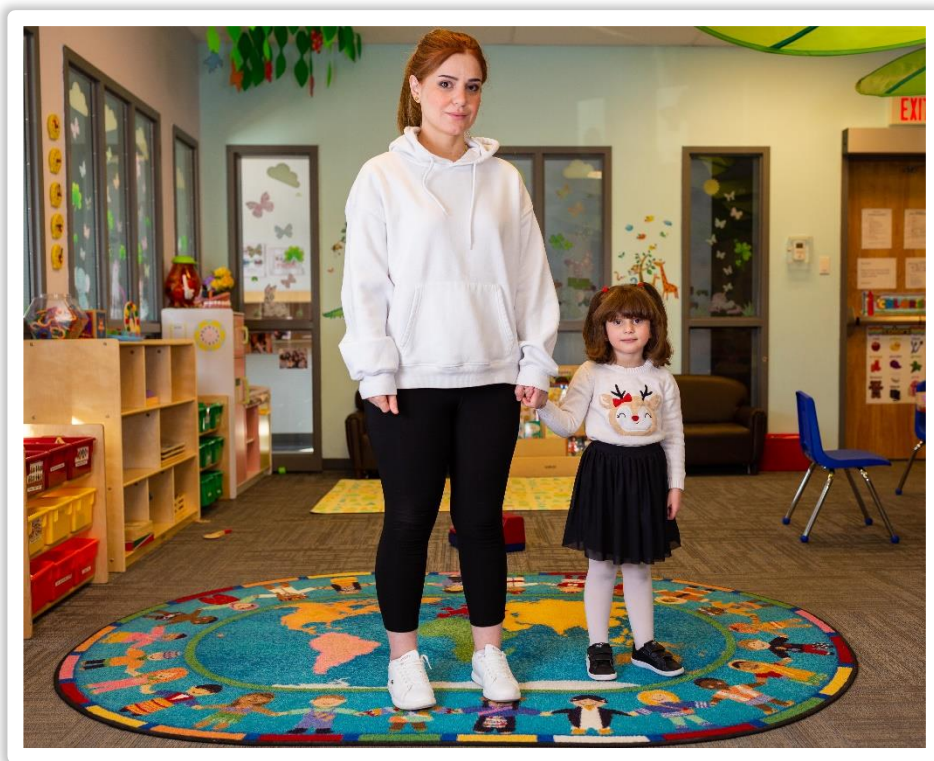
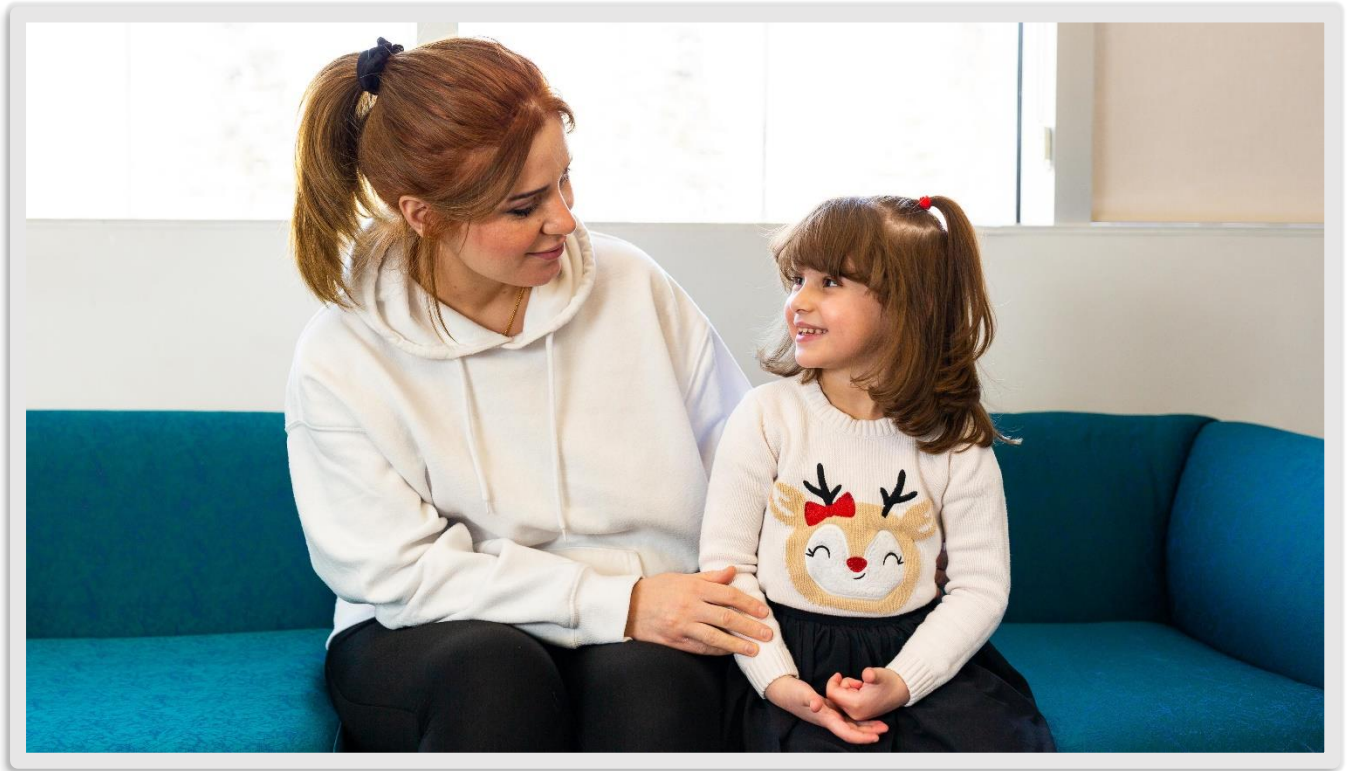

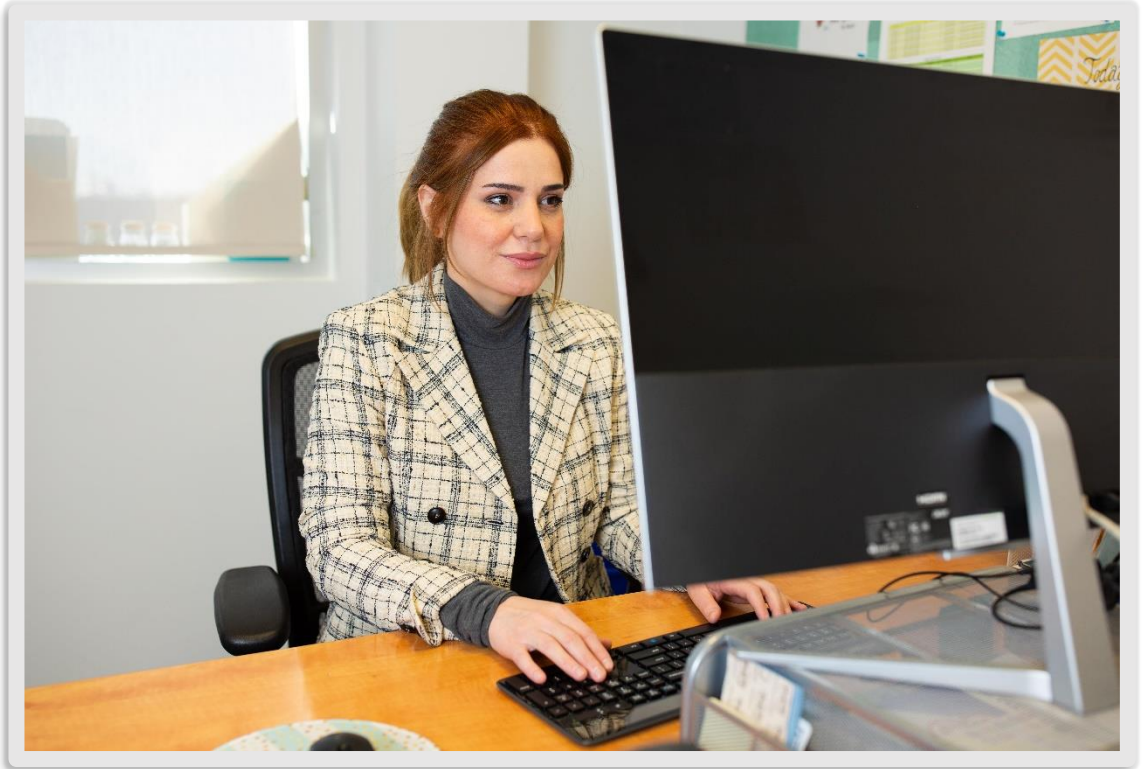

Fatima asks the daycare staff a few questions.

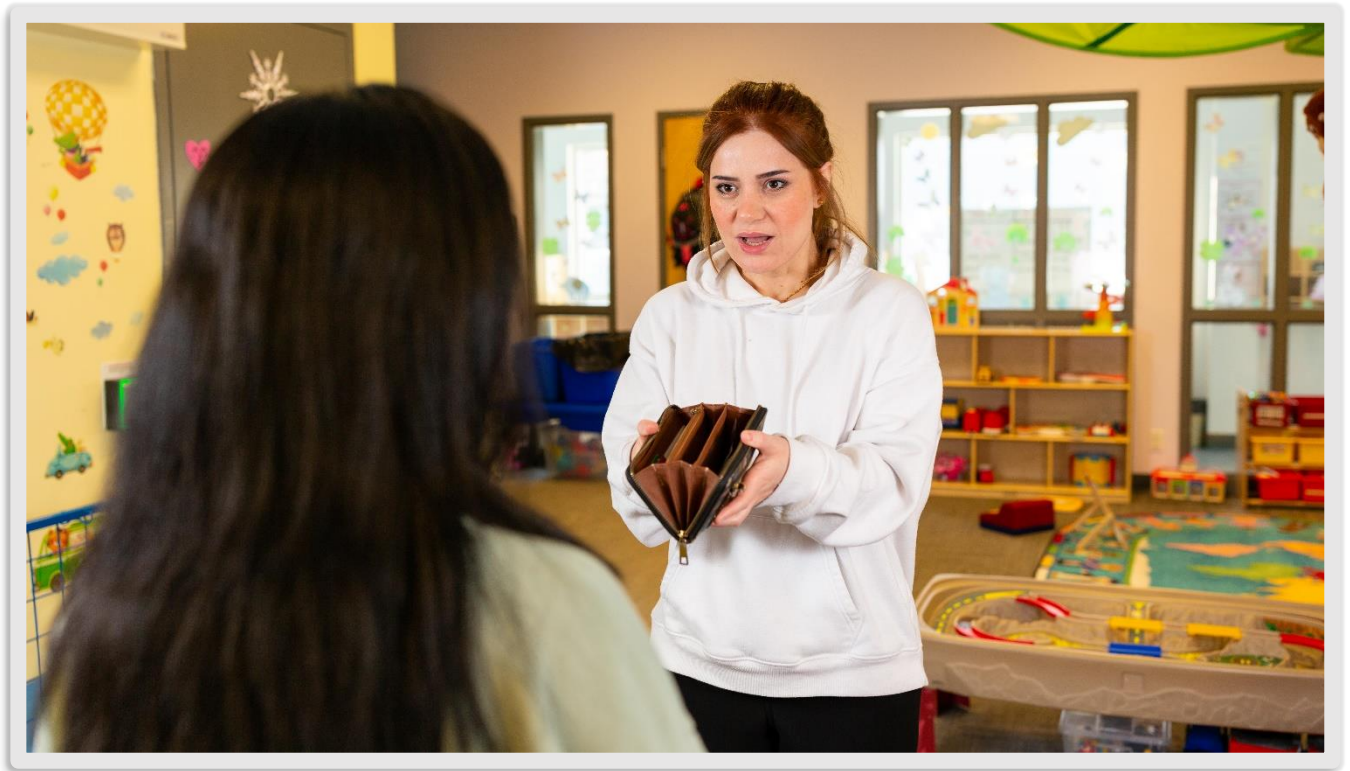




Does she need to pack her daughter snacks or lunch?



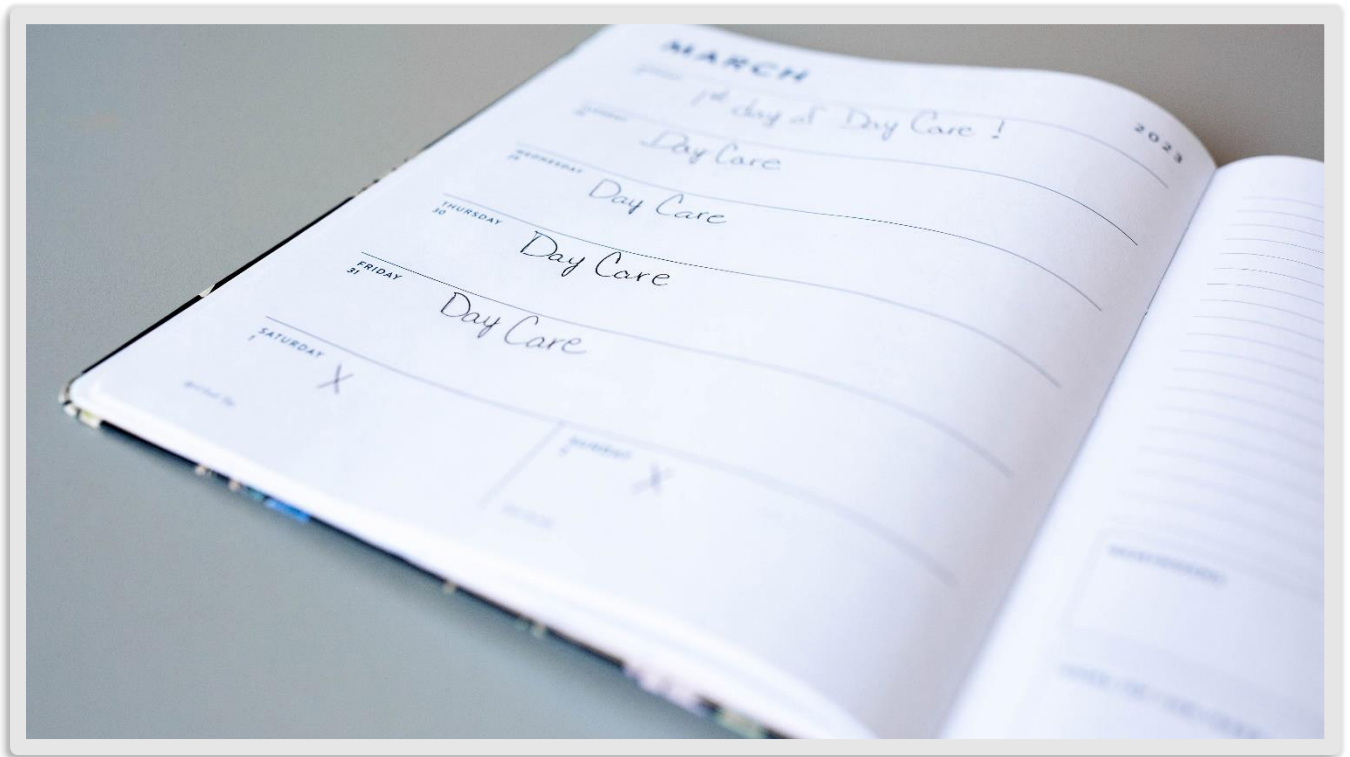
Is the daycare open on Saturdays or Sundays? Is it open on holidays?



How much does she have to pay?



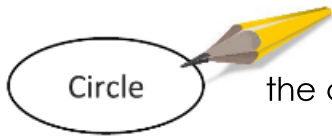
The daycare staff answers her questions and they make a plan.

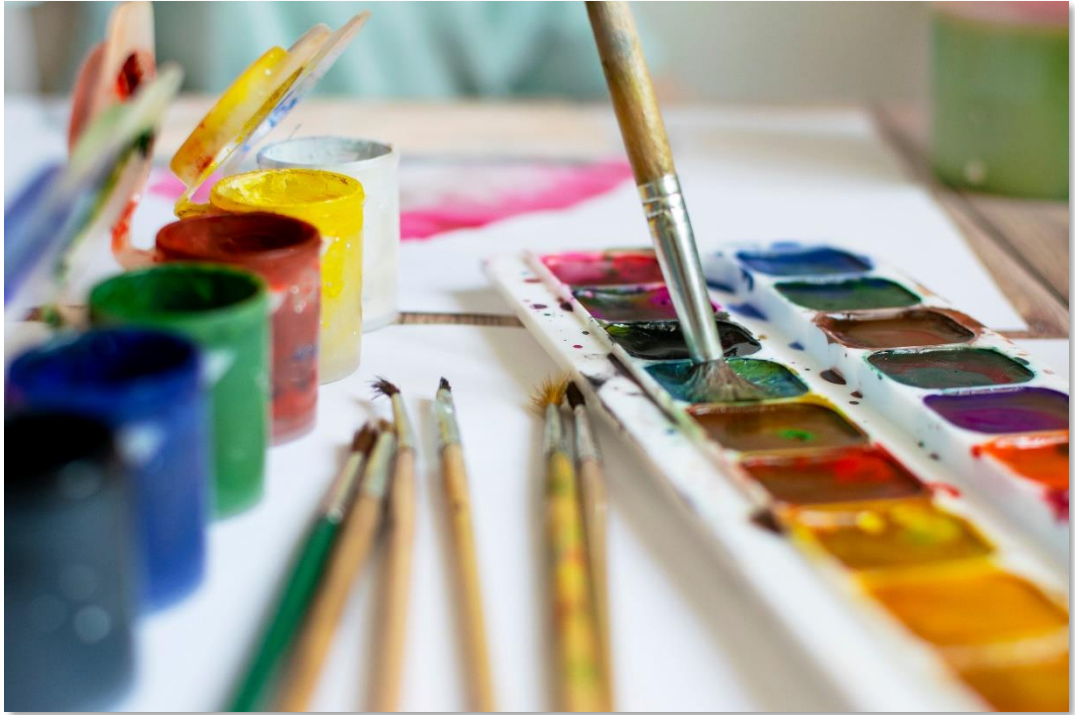
