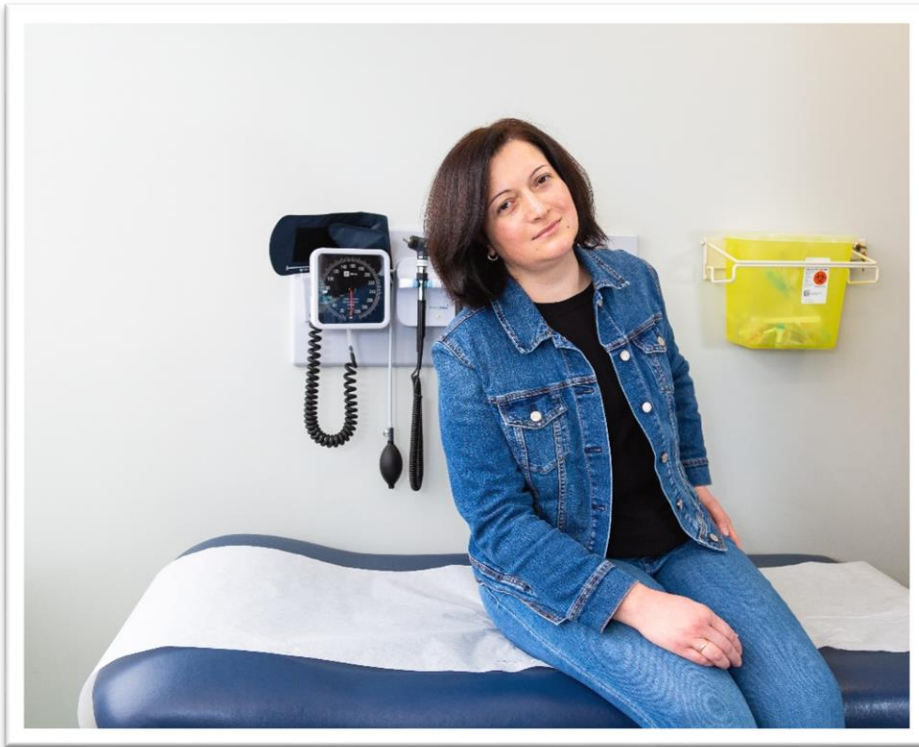

The doctor asks Irina why her hip is sore.

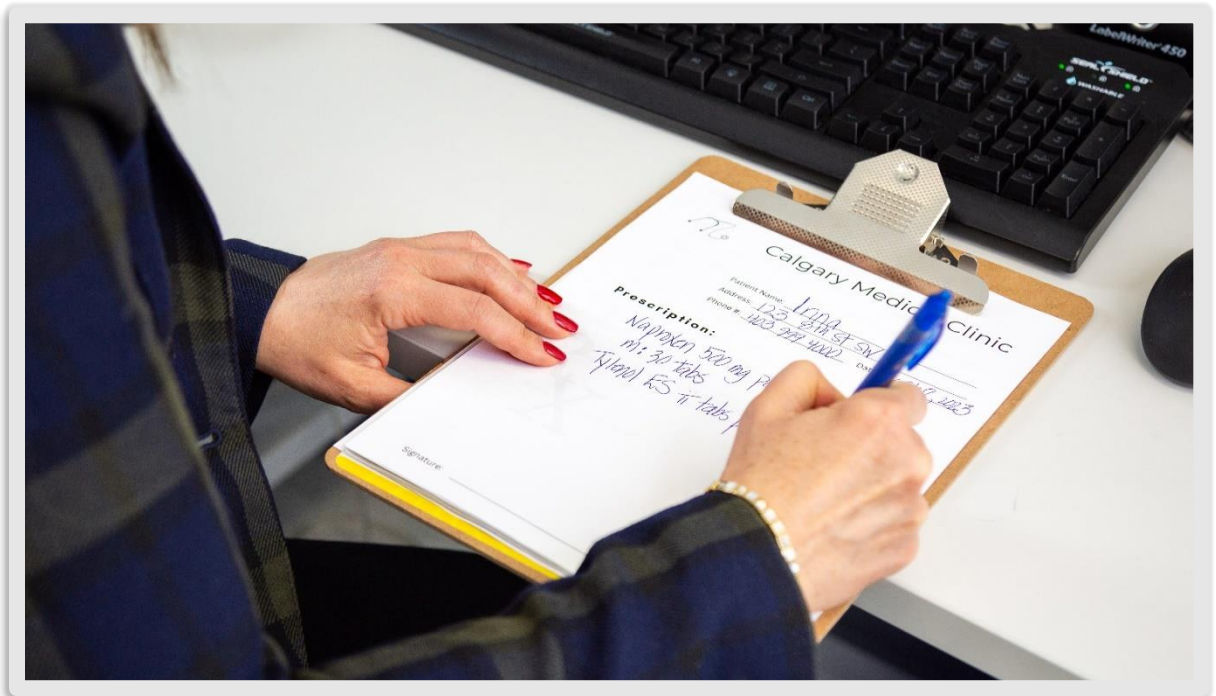


She says “I was walking last night and slipped on some ice.”

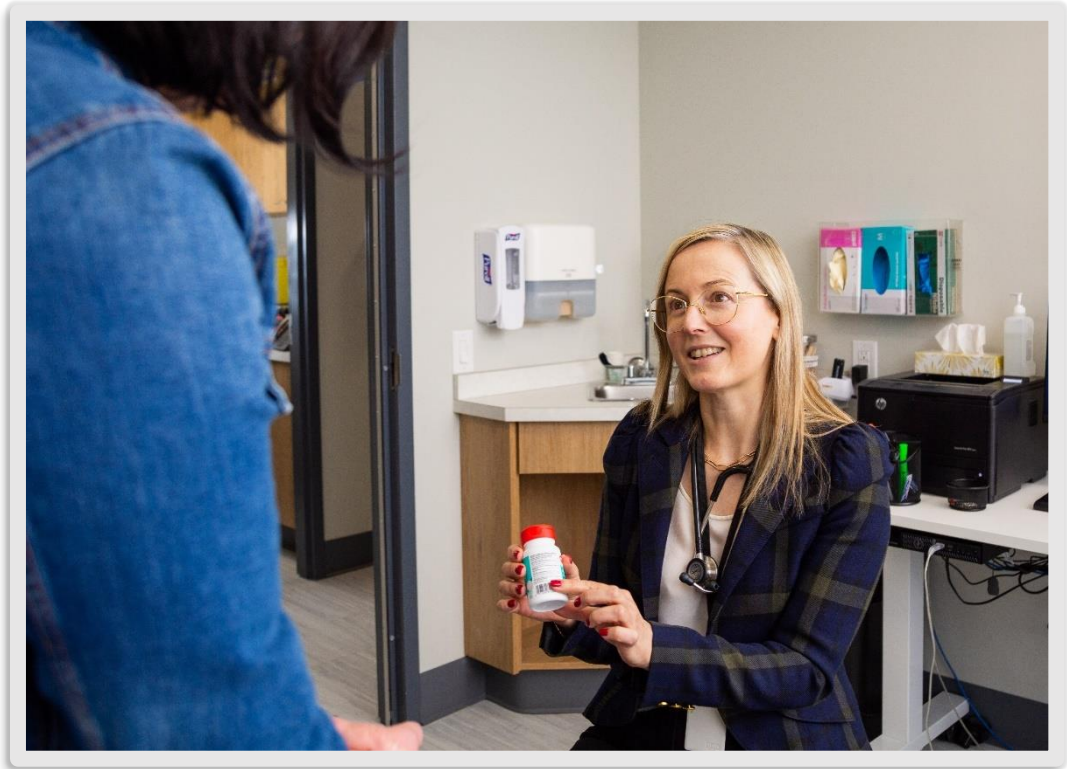


First the doctor looks at her hip.

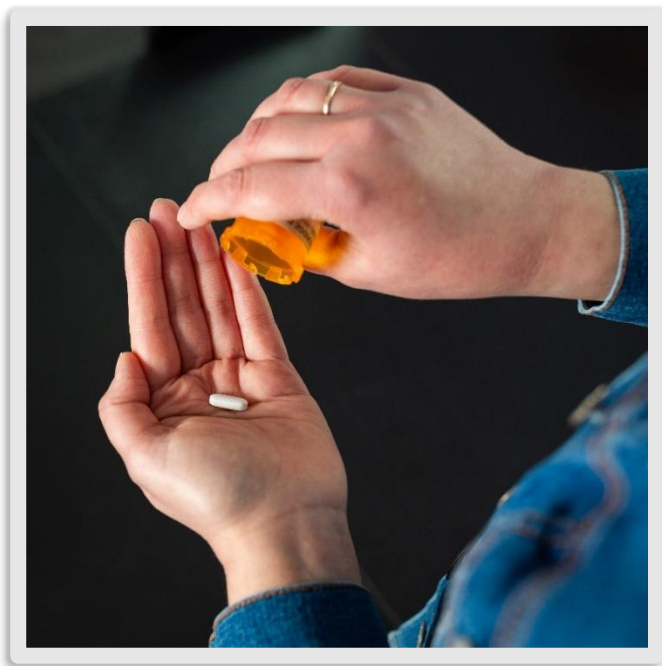




Next she writes Irina a prescription for a painkiller.



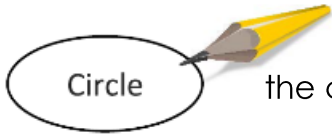
She tells Irina to take one pill twice per day until the pain stops.
