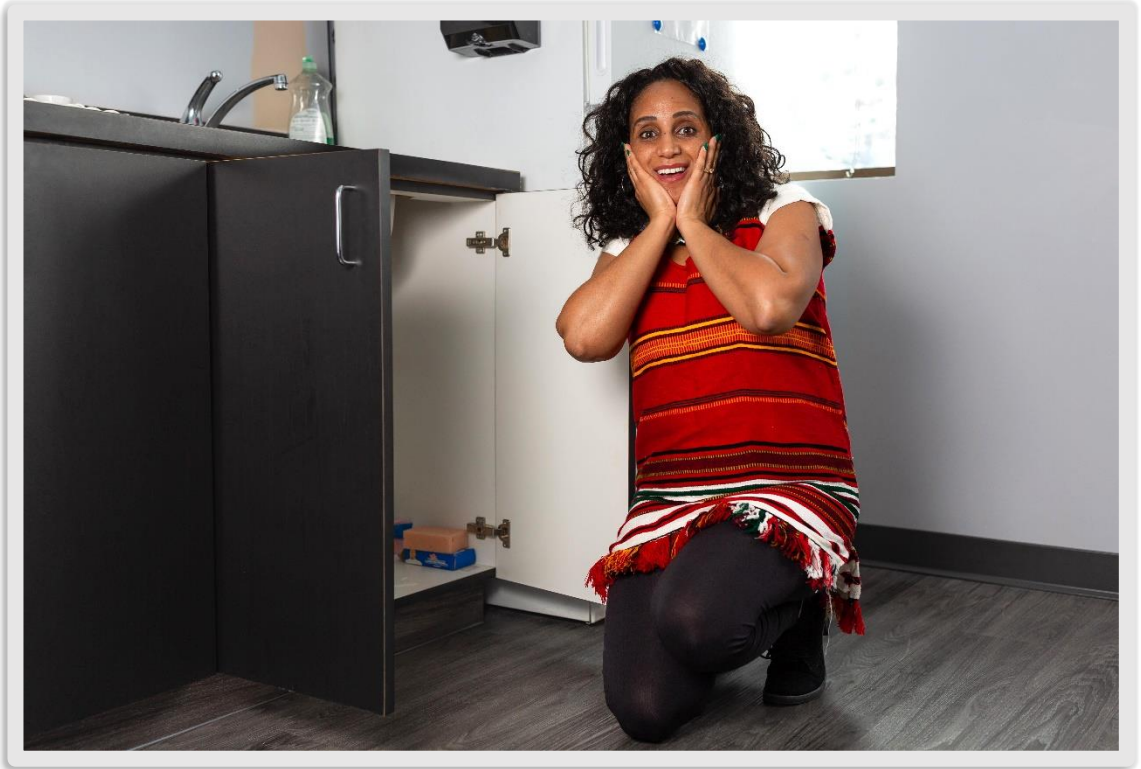
Bisrat is at the kitchen sink washing dishes.

She takes everything out from inside the cupboard.



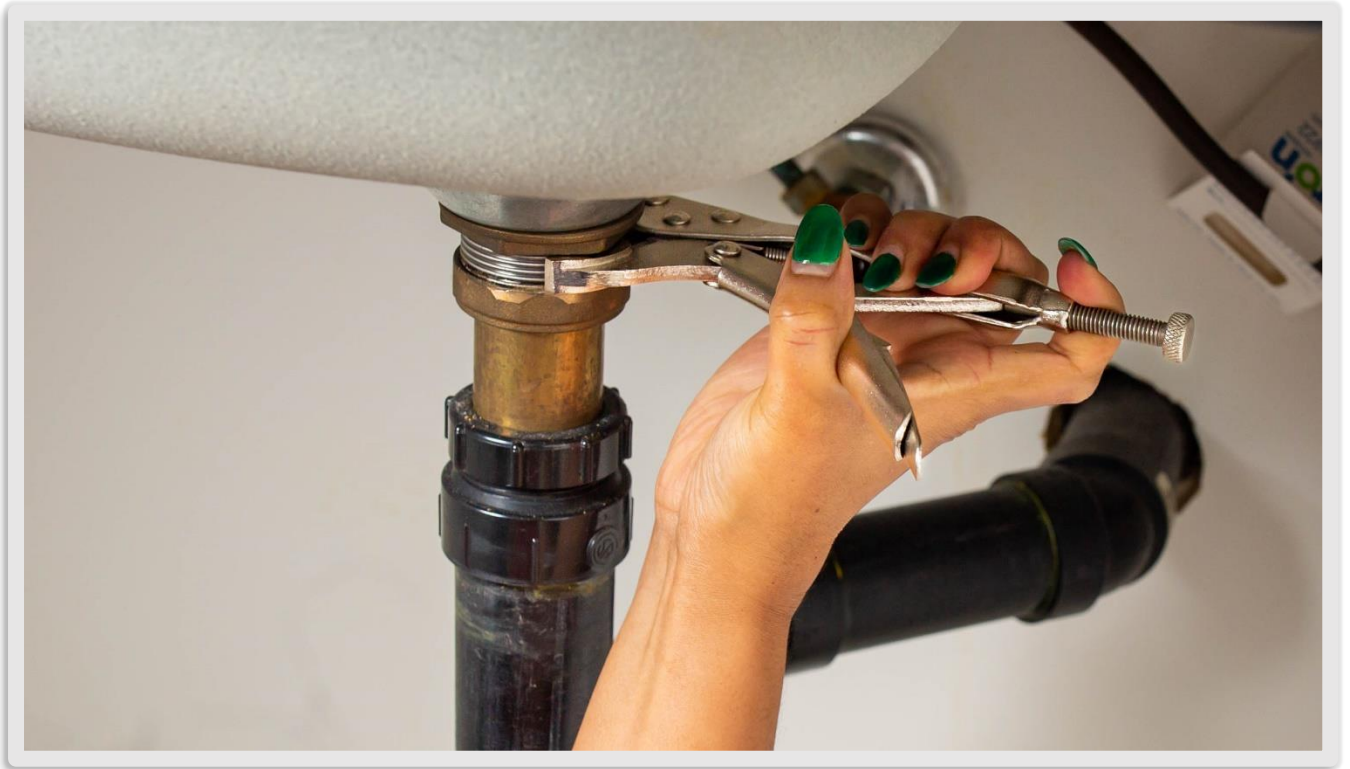
She finds pliers and a flashlight.
