The teacher tells the two men “You should watch a soccer game together over lunch!”



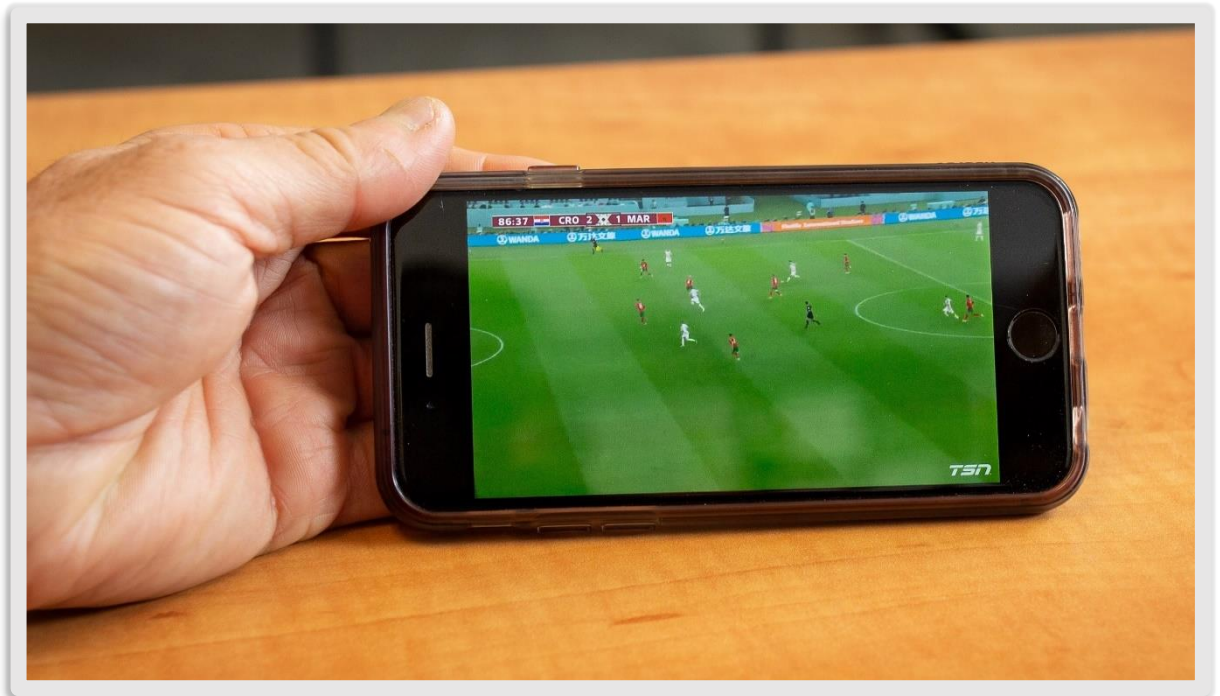
So Muhammad goes to the store and buys popcorn and some soda.

The score is two to one.



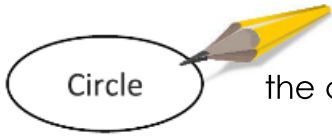
Jonas says “I hope Croatia scores another goal.”
